Randy Goetz – Randy expressed concerns from Kingsbury neighbors about the entry to Kingsbury off Skinker. Parking patterns and foliage growth at the entry has made entrance on to Skinker from Kingsbury a dangerous prospect. Randy submitted a petition from the Kingsbury neighbors to the City of St. Louis to eliminate street parking on the East side of Skinker between McPherson and Kingsbury.

Brandon mentioned that eliminating parking on the East side of Skinker may cause an increase in transient parking on streets intersecting Skinker. (McPherson, Kingsbury, Washington).

Cheryl asked if parking restrictions be made during peak travel hours? Another proposal was to open one way streets to thru traffic.

Randy asked on behalf of the petition signers that the SDCC Board support their efforts.

Action: Brandon will meet with pertinent representatives to initiate discussions on this conversation.
